Sometimes, trying new things can be hard!






Sometimes, I may need help. My parent or Port Discovery Play Expert can help me.

I can look inside a sarcophagus. Looking inside can be fun!







I can walk through the hallways. There will be different sounds.





I may not like the sounds. I can ask for help and I can leave the hallway.






I can touch objects in a box. I can try to feel inside to know which picture it matches. Touching things can be fun.

Overview:

Scripted stories help children understand how to respond and interact in unfamiliar situations, activities or events. These stories are written to assist children in social situations. When children are more prepared and understand the expectations of a situation this helps to minimize possible problem behaviors that might occur. These stories can be utilized by teachers, parents and child care providers.

These stories are a tool to help a child prepare for a new situation and to address a challenging behavior within that new setting or situation. These scripted stories can be modified. Real photographs can be used instead of clip art. Please note that you can use real photographs of the child and change the wording to make it more personalized for your child or a student.
