In Tot Trails, I can play here!








There are different things to see and do.

I can play with sand toys. I can keep the toys near the sand area.







I may want to play with all the toys, but I may need to share.

I can watch the leaves blow in the air. I can pick up the leaves. Watching the leaves can be fun!






I can play with the gears. I can move the gears.

Overview:

Scripted stories help children understand how to respond and interact in unfamiliar situations, activities or events. These stories are written to assist children in social situations. When children are more prepared and understand the expectations of a situation this helps to minimize possible problem behaviors that might occur. These stories can be utilized by teachers, parents and child care providers.

These stories are a tool to help a child prepare for a new situation and to address a challenging behavior within that new setting or situation. These scripted stories can be modified. Real photographs can be used instead of clip art. Please note that you can use real photographs of the child and change the wording to make it more personalized for your child or a student.
